



Online Choirs: How to carry out virtual choir rehearsals with the help of digital tools

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Project motivation

- During the COVID-19 pandemic, some choirs started to experiment with online rehearsals
- Experiences from the pandemic show that singing and conducting in online environments basically works
- However, by far not all choirs were able to switch to online modes of interaction
- Singing together in the digital space comes with unique requirements
- Barriers preventing the use of digital tools may relate to
 - Limitations of existing tools and lack of technical skills
 - Lack of best practices and guidelines how conducting can be done in a virtual environment
 - Perceptions that singing online is less
 enjoyable than singing face-to-face



Goals

- 1) Identification of the state-of-the-art of online choir rehearsals
- 2) Design of **technology solutions and principles** for carrying out online choir rehearsals
- 3) Application and **evaluation** of the designed technology solutions and principles in an **online laboratory choir**
- 4) Communication and dissemination of the results of the project
